Below are the assessments and the scores required to qualify for the specific program listed. Please be aware that some options may incur a cost which is the responsibility of the applicant. Please contact the Admissions Office if you are unable to complete an assessment in person.

Students who hold an Associate Degree or higher level degree may provide college transcripts to substitute for the Entrance Assessment requirement.

Entrance Assessment options:

- 1. **ACT WorkKeys** The ACT WorkKeys is an assessment used to measure foundational skills required for success in the workplace and helps measure the workplace skills that can affect job performance. Available at most Alaska Job Centers and some high schools across the state. Please call ahead to confirm they can administer the assessment and have availability.
- 2. **ASVAB** The Armed Services Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) assessment is an aptitude test that helps predict future academic and occupational success. The ASVAB is utilized by many high schools across the state as a career exploration tool. Please contact your high school counselor to discuss this option.

- 3. **TABE Test** The Adult Basic Education (TABE) assessment for math and reading. Available in many Alaska Job Centers, Native Village Corporations and Education Centers across the state. Please call ahead to confirm they can administer the assessment and have availability.
- 4. **TABE Academy** If you are unable to complete an assessment in person, please contact the Admissions Office for information regarding the TABE Academy. The TABE Academy is an online course using skill-based lessons, to determine individual readiness in math and reading as applied for the greatest success in training.
