

## **Are you a new AVTEC student or returning as an AVTEC student in January 2021?**

### **What are the expectations for arriving on campus?**

1. **ALL students**, (on and off campus residents) will need to check in with the dorm office upon arrival to Seward and provide a negative PCR COVID-19 test result from a test administered on January 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, or 8<sup>th</sup>. Individuals who tested positive for the coronavirus within the previous 90 days should submit their 'Letter of Declaration' from the Division of Public Health. 2. Students who are still awaiting results as of Monday, January 11<sup>th</sup> at 8:30am will be required to lay-low in their housing units and any time missed from training is the responsibility of the student to make up with their instructor. Reports of non-compliance will be investigated by administration and subject to discipline.
3. Students who will be living on campus are invited to move in on Saturday 1/9/21 or Sunday 1/10/21. Use the sign-up genius above for reservations to check in to the dorms.

5. If you arrive without evidence of testing or a negative test result, you can call for testing times and appointments in Seward at the following locations:
  - Seward Community Health Center 907-224-2273
  - Glacier Family Medicine Clinic 907-224-8733
  - North Star Health Clinic (For Alaska Native students) 907-224-3490
6. Class will start as scheduled on Monday, January 11 at 8:30am for students with negative test results.
7. On Tuesday, January 19<sup>th</sup> all students will need a follow up confirmation test. Mass testing will be conducted on the AVTEC campus. Any students who prefer to test off site are responsible for their own appointment and must provide evidence of testing on January 19<sup>th</sup> and negative results or status check no later than Thursday, January 21<sup>st</sup> to dorm office. All students **without** symptoms can participate in training (while following health protocols) while awaiting results from this round of testing. Reports of non-compliance will be investigated by administration and subject to discipline. \*
8. After all confirmation testing results are obtained, AVTEC will return to the healthy practices that have been in place for the rest of the school year: masks in all common areas and when unable to maintain 6-foot distance in classroom/lab, wash hands often, stay in training program bubbles, and do not come to school sick.

\*Any non-compliance with these expectations during this start/restart timeframe could result in disciplinary action, including eviction from student housing and/or dismissal from training. If you are unwilling or unable to comply with these expectations, you have the option to wait and attend AVTEC after the pandemic.
